Annual Congregational Meeting follows the worship service January 16, *not January 19 as stated in the newsletter.*

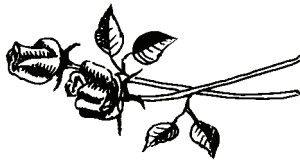
