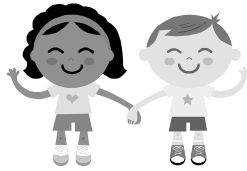
BLACK FRIDAY BABYSITTING SERVICE

The Presbyterian Women are taking orders for angel ornaments to adorn the Christmas tree that will be in the sanctuary.

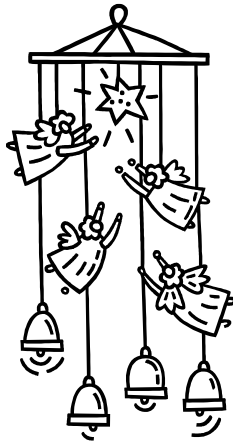

The Church is taking orders for poinsettias to add beauty to our sanctuary during the Christmas season. If you would like to purchase one, the cost is \$12.50.

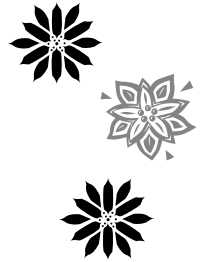
