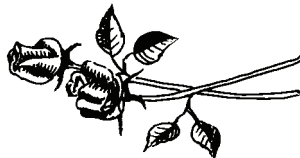

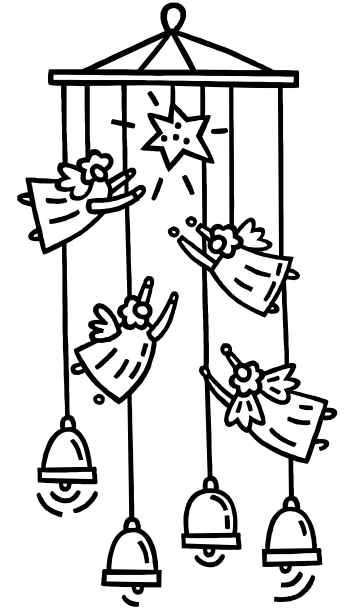
## CHRISTMAS ORNAMENTS
