2012 PW Missions

Rosemary Runyard, coordinator for Mission Opportunities, has chosen the MotherHouse Crisis Nursery as the mission project for this year. We will dedicate items on Thank Offering Sunday, November 11. MotherHouse Crisis Nursery, is located in Rockford and is a division of Children's Home & Aid. It's goal is to help families during an emergency, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Any family can bring their child, newborn through 6 years of age to MotherHouse for up to three days. They are provided with hot meals, a warm bed, a bath and are cared for by licensed and loving staff.

What is a crisis? A crisis includes: homelessness, a medical emergency, unemployment, stresses of parents, substance abuse meetings, a fire, a power outage. A crisis means "not having any way of taking care of your child!"

Here is a "wish list" of items most needed:

Child care items needed:

Baby wipes, baby lotion, diaper rash ointment
Pull-ups (size large) Diapers size 4, 5, and 6

Cleaning supplies needed:

Paper towels, dish soap, and 13 gallon trash bags

Food items:

Peanut butter, spaghetti, macaroni and cheese, pudding
Canned Goods and baby food
Cheese or Peanut butter cracker packs
