The Presbyterian Women are taking orders for angel ornaments to adorn the Christmas tree that will be in the sanctuary.

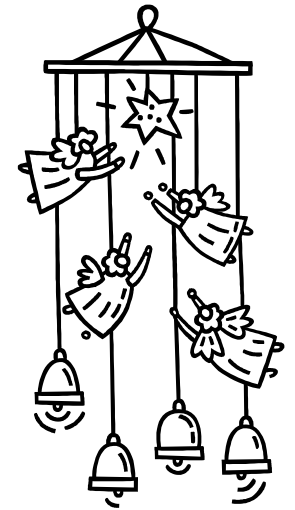
Orders due by November 21, the tree will be decorated on the 27th.
